I-V	From the foundation of the City to its conquest by the Gauls (386 BC)	All books extant. All periochae extant.
<u>VI*-XV</u>	To the subjugation of Italy (265 BC)	Books VI-X extant. All periochae extant. Minor fragments possibly from Books XII and XIV
XVI-XX	The Punic Wars to the beginning of the War with Hannibal (219 BC)	All books lost. All periochae extant. Minor fragments of all books
XXI*-XXX	The War with Hannibal (to 201 BC)	All books extant. All periochae extant.
XXXI*-XL	To the death of Philip of Macedon (179 BC)	All books extant. All periochae extant.
XLI-LXX	To the outbreak of the Social War (91 BC)	Most of Books XLI & XLIV and Books XLII, XLIII and XLV extant. All periochae extant. Minor fragments of XLIX and LVI.
LXXI-LXXX	The Social War to the death of Marius (86 BC)	All books lost. All periochae extant. Minor fragments of LXXVII.
LXXXI-XC	To the death of Sulla (78 BC)	All books lost. All periochae extant. Minor fragments of LXXXIII.
XCI-CVIII	From the War with Sertorius to Caesar's Gallic War (58 BC)	All books lost. All periochae extant. Major fragment of XVI (Sertorius in Spain). Minor fragments of XCI, XCIV, XCVII, XCVIII, XCIX, CII, CIII and CV.
CIX-CXVI	From the beginning of the Civil Wars to the death of Caesar (44 BC).	All books lost. All periochae extant. Minor fragments of CIX, CX, CXI, CXII, CXIII, CXIV and CXVI.
CXVII-CXXXIII	To the death of Antony and Cleopatra (30 BC)	All books lost. All periochae extant. Major fragment of CXX (Death of Cicero). Minor fragments of CXVIII, CXXVII and CXXXIII.
CXXXIV-CXLII	The Principate of Augustus to the death of Drusus (9 BC).	All books lost. All periochae extant except CXXXVI and CXXXVII (25-15 BC). Minor frags. of CXXXV and CXXXVI.
